Show Rules and Regulations

The Miniature Australian Shepherd Club (MASCA) sanctions all legitimate shows and matches registering the Australian Shepherd of the miniature variety for championship titles. I ABCA, CKC, Canine KC, FORB, Rarities, Rare Heirs, YWC, UKC (Note: One major must come from a venue which offers classes for the miniature size variety as a separate class. This major must be earned at breed level.), RBCSWO, NCA, etc. shows and those nationally advertised in magazines, newsletters, etc. are automatically sanctioned. In order to confirm wins at any other show, please attach a photocopy of the show flyer when submitting the Winsheets. If no flyer is available, contact MASCA prior to the show.

MASCA grants championships and performance titles to dogs that meet all requirements as set forth in this Show Rules and Regulations. A MASCA Championship Certificate will then be issued to the owner of the dog, and the owner of the dog will have the right to use the title on all registration and pedigree certificates.

1) A dog must earn the number of championship points noted in the correct section below. At least two of these wins must be major wins (shows which are at least three-point shows). One of the two majors must be at the Breed Level. Majors must be under different judges. Dogs must also have at least one more win under a third judge.

2) A dog must be registered with MASCA. If the dog is not registered with MASCA prior to the show, it must be registered with MASCA within thirty (30) days of date of show. A dog that is not registered with MASCA may be entered in no more than two sanctioned shows without being registered with MASC. The exhibitor must hold the Winsheets until enough points have been earned for the championship. Copies should be made and kept before mailing Winsheets to MASCA. *It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to have Winsheets available for the judges and show chairperson on the day of the show.* Winsheets must be signed at Co-sanctioned Specialties. Winsheets are not required for Regional Specialties and Nationals but must be listed on the Championship/Merit Application form.

I. CHAMPION. In order to become a MASCA Champion, a dog must earn 15 points and be at least six (6) months of age on the day of the show. Only dogs taking Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Winners, Best Opposite Sex or Best of Breed placements are eligible for conformation champion points. For Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, one (1) pt. is earned for each class dog of the same sex defeated for a max of 5 pts. Best of Winners can earn extra points (up to the max of 5) for dogs of the opposite sex defeated. If Best of Winners is the same sex as Best Of Opposite Sex, Best of Opposite Sex will receive points for both male and female class dogs defeated. The Best of Breed winner will then compete in Herding Group competition where *additional* points may be earned. In Group competition, the dog earns one point for each dog it defeats. The First in Group will compete in Best in Show where *additional* points may be earned. In Best in Show competition, the dog earns one point for each dog it defeats.

I ABCA Show Information

This particular show venue offers a schedule of classes that differ from the usual schedule of classes (ie. no Winners class). An entrant must first request a Winners class to be held prior to the Best of Breed class to be eligible to obtain conformation points. This Winners class should include all eligible dogs or bitches over 6 months of age. I ABCA is aware of our policies and is compliant. Speak to the show secretary on the day of show to request a Winners class to be held prior to the Best of Breed class. MASCA only recognizes wins (BOB, B I S, etc) in the regular Adult classes for this venue, not the Puppy classes or the non-regular Bred-By Best In Show class (refer to <http://www.iabca.com/Classes.htm>). All other MASCA show rules and regulations apply.

CHAMPION POINT SCHEDULE (schedule indicates number of dogs DEFEATED)

1 dog defeated	1 point
2 dogs defeated	2 points
3 dogs defeated	3 points
4 dogs defeated	4 points
5+ dogs defeated	5 points

If only one dog of each sex is present, Best of Breed, and only Best of Breed, will be awarded one (1) point. The maximum number of points a dog may earn toward Champion title at any one show is five (5) even in the case of Best in Show, etc. wins.

ALTERED CHAMPION. See rules above, except majors are not required.

II. GRAND CHAMPION.

Before a dog may earn points towards its Grand Championship, it must be a CONFIRMED MASCA Champion. In order to become a Grand Champion a dog must earn fifty (50) points, and obtain five (5) majors at breed level, under different judges. Three (3) of the five (5) majors must be 5-point majors. Points earned toward the dog s Championship shall not count.

Best of Breed receives one (1) point for each dog defeated at regular class and Best of Breed level.

Best of Opposite Sex receives one (1) point for each dog of its sex defeated.

If Best of Winners is the same sex as Best Of Opposite Sex, Best of Opposite Sex receive points for both male and female class dogs defeated.

III. THE MERIT PROGRAM

MASCA POINT SYSTEM FOR TOP TEN CONFORMATION DOGS OF EACH RECORDING YEAR.

BOB receives one (1) point for each dog (includes all regular class and specials dogs) defeated.

BOS receives one (1) point for each dog (includes all regular class and specials dogs) of its sex defeated.

If Best of Winners is the same sex as Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Opposite Sex receive points for both male and female class dogs defeated.

Champions and Class Dogs and Bitches are eligible for the above points. Winsheets for merit must be postmarked on or before January 15th of each calendar year, and submitted with a completed Championship/Merit Application form. Top Ten conformation points are accumulated and lists are published on the website.
